

# THE TOYOTA SHOOTOFF

## OFFICIAL RULES

### QUALIFICATIONS

1. One (1) 2020 Hoopfest Customized Camry will be given away in the 2020 Toyota Shootoff contest, concluding on October 24, 2020. The 2020 Toyota Shootoff is sponsored by the Inland Empire Toyota Dealers Association. The 2020 Toyota Shootoff contest is organized and operated by Spokane Hoopfest Association (SHA).
2. The sole winner of the 2020 Toyota Shootoff contest will win a 2020 Hoopfest Customized Toyota Camry provided by SHA. The 2020 Hoopfest Customized Toyota Camry will be on display during the contest.
3. Contestants must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
4. The odds of winning depend on the number of entries and contestants.
5. Entries into the raffle can be purchased at the following prices: 1 entry for \$5, 5 entries for \$20, 30 entries for \$100, and 50 entries for \$150. A person may only qualify one time for this contest.
6. The contest winner is responsible for all taxes and license fees pertaining to the 2020 Hoopfest Customized Toyota Camry, which must be satisfied prior to its receipt. The winner will be entitled to actual possession of the 2020 Toyota Camry sometime during the week following the 2020 Toyota Shootoff contest.
7. Employees of any Inland Empire Toyota dealer, Hoopfest, Hoopfest board members, spouses and immediate family, E2 Media, and all identified, direct promotional partners associated with this contest, including their parents, spouses and children, are ineligible to win this contest.
8. Contestants must sign any appropriate qualification certificate and waiver as required by Hoopfest.

### DEFINITIONS

1. Spokane Hoopfest Association: A Washington nonprofit corporation and tax-exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (“Hoopfest”).
2. Elevated Shot: A basketball shot taken from an identified location inside the U.S. Pavilion in Spokane’s Riverfront Park from the “Elevated Experience” 40 feet above the U.S. Pavilion floor above the specified basketball structure.

### PROCEDURES

1. Wednesday, October 21 at 5:00 p.m. – The 10 contestants will be drawn at random live on Facebook Live. We will then notify the winners by email immediately following the drawing to confirm participation in the contest. If any of the 10 drawn contestants chooses not to participate, we will replace them by selecting another contestant at random.

### PROCEDURES (CONT.)

2. Saturday, October 24 from approximately 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. – Toyota Shootoff
  - a. First Round for all qualifiers: Five Elevated Experience shots. Prior to the beginning of this round, each contestant will have the opportunity to shoot two practice shots. The practice shots will not count. Once each contestant has taken their two practice shots, the First Round of five shots each will officially begin. Make one of these five shots to advance to the Final Round. Contestants will shoot in the order in which they were drawn in the raffle for practice and contest shots. Those who don’t make any of the five shots are out of the contest. If no individual makes the shot, this round will repeat with the similar format, but instead of 5 shots per person, each contestant will take 3 shots until at least two individuals makes the shot.
  - b. Final Round for all contestants who advanced: One Elevated Experience shot. Each contestant that advanced will have an opportunity to shoot one shot in the same order as in the First Round. If only one person makes the shot, that person wins the designated 2020 Toyota Camry. If two or more make the shot, those individuals advance and those who missed are eliminated. If no one makes the first shot, the contestants will shoot a second time from the Elevated Experience, subject to the same procedures as described above. In the event the second round of shots are completed without a single winner, the third and remaining rounds of finals shots will occur: One Elevated Experience shot. During the Final Round, contestants will be eliminated on a “make it or out” basis until only one individual makes the shot in any given round and remains. The person making his/her last shot during the Final Round, when all other remaining finalists have missed their shot, wins the 2020 Hoopfest Customized Toyota Camry.
3. Shooting times are subject to change. Contestants must check the posted times at the designated court. Failure of a contestant to be present during the posted times will result in disqualification.
4. Eligibility, age and claims made by winners are subject to verification. By accepting the prize, the winner consents to the use of his/her name, likeness and photographs for advertising, trade and promotional purposes in all media without additional compensation.
5. There is no limit to the amount of tickets that will be sold. The chances of winning are based on the total number of tickets sold. By entering this raffle, each participant releases SHA, its directors, officers, employees and agents from any and all liability for injuries, losses or damages of any kind caused by participating in the raffle or winning any prize or resulting from acceptance, possession, use or misuse of any prize, and each winner agrees to indemnify and hold SHA harmless from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims and actions of any kind rising in connection with or as a result of participating in the raffle or the winner's acceptance or use of any prize.

### ELIGIBILITY

Anyone 18 years of age or older may enter. Employees of any Inland Empire Toyota dealer, SHA, SHA board members, spouses and immediate family, E2 Media, and all identified, direct promotional partners associated with this contest, including their parents, spouses and children, are ineligible to win this contest. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. The raffle is void where prohibited or restricted by law. An affidavit of eligibility may be required from prize winners.

### DETERMINING WINNERS

Ticket stubs from all sales will be placed into a receptacle at the SHA headquarters. On Wednesday, October 21 at 5:00pm, SHA staff will randomly select 10 contestants from the receptacle live on Facebook Live. Contestants will be notified immediately following the drawing. If any of the 10 contestants are not able to attend the Toyota Shootoff in person, a new contestant will be drawn from the receptacle. The 10 selected contestants then must compete in the Toyota Shootoff on Saturday, October 24 in order to have a chance at winning the 2020 Toyota Camry.

### PURCHASING TICKETS

Entries into the raffle can be purchased at the following prices: 1 entry for \$5, 5 entries for \$20, 30 entries for \$100, and 50 entries for \$150. A person may only qualify one time for this contest. Only one method of payment, one name, and one mailing address are permitted per entry pack. Only one eligible person may be entered in the raffle per ticket sold. If the name of more than one person is submitted with a ticket purchase, and that ticket is selected as a winning ticket, then the person named first will be deemed the holder of record of that ticket and declared the winner regardless of who paid for the ticket.
